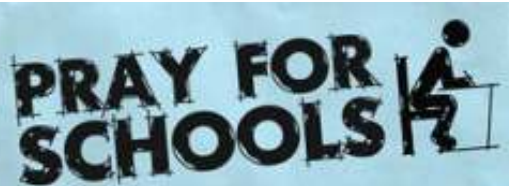

## Salford Priors Remembrance Service

This year the Remembrance service will take place at the Memorial Hall in the village and will start at 10.25am with the unveiling and Dedication of the new War Memorial. The service will then take place in the hall after which the wreaths will be taken outside and laid on the War Memorial.

There will be seating for about 100 people in the hall, so it may be that you will be asked to stand for the service which will last about 45 minutes.
